## **FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for a Roadway Project**

*State Road (SR) 817/NW 27 Avenue from NW 156 Street to NW 159 Street*

---

**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public hearing for a roadway safety project along SR 817/NW 27 Avenue from NW 156 Street to NW 159 Street, in Miami-Dade County. Construction start date is to be determined, but the project is expected to last one month. The estimated construction cost of the project is \$137,260.

**The public hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, March 27, 2018, at the Sherbondy Village, Auditorium, 215 N. Perviz Avenue, Opa-locka, FL 33054.** The hearing will begin as an open house, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., with a formal presentation starting at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the hearing, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Restricting the left turn movement from NW 159 Street to northbound NW 27 Avenue
- Modifying the median at NW 159 Street to enforce movement restriction
- Extending southbound left turn storage length at NW 156 Street to accommodate additional vehicles
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Reconstructing curb ramps
- Enhancing signing and pavement markings
