Next Segment of State Road (SR) 997/ Krome Avenue Projects Completed

Project Final Accepted on March 10

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) completed the sixth of several SR 997/Krome Avenue Roadway Projects on March 10, 2018. The project extended along Krome Avenue from SW 136 Street to just south of SR 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive in Miami-Dade County. It started on September 6, 2016, and featured more than \$33 million in roadway and safety improvements including the following work:

- Widening the road from two lanes to four lanes
- Constructing a 40-foot media
- Upgrading drainage where necessary
- Upgrading traffic signals and road signs

FDOT has completed this project with the support of community groups and elected officials. General Asphalt Co. was the contractor.

“The Department is committed to safety for all its projects,” said District Six Secretary James Wolfe, P.E. “We are proud to continue to deliver Krome Avenue roadway and safety enhancements that benefit our community.”

Construction continues between Kendall Drive and Tamiami Trail. Additional projects are currently in the planning and design phases. All projects have the goal of enhancing mobility and creating a safe corridor for vehicles, bicyclists and pedestrians.
