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## FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for Two Roadway Projects

*State Road (SR) 5/US 1/S. Dixie Highway from Riviera Drive to I-95*

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**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public hearing for two roadway projects along SR 5/US 1/S. Dixie Highway from Riviera Drive to I-95, in Miami-Dade County. The estimated combined construction cost of these projects is \$6.6 million. The construction schedule for each project is listed below:

- **SR 5/US 1/S. Dixie Highway from Riviera Drive to SW 27 Avenue:**  
Work is expected to begin in November 2019 and last about 10 months.
- **SR 5/US 1/S. Dixie Highway from SW 27 Avenue to SR 9A/I-95:**  
Work is expected to begin in July 2019 and last about 11 months.

**The public hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, April 17, 2018, at the Coral Gables Library, 3443 Segovia Street, Coral Gables, FL 33134.** A formal presentation will start at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the hearing, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss these projects.

The proposed work for these projects include:

**SR 5/US 1/S. Dixie Highway from Riviera Drive to SW 27 Avenue:**

- Repaving and restriping along the roadway SR 5/US 1/S. Dixie Highway
- Upgrading sidewalks and pavement markings
- Improving traffic and pedestrian signals, lighting and signage
- Adjusting manholes

**SR 5/US 1/S. Dixie Highway from SW 27 Avenue to I-95:**

- Modifying the intersection to restrict left-turn movements at SR 5/US 1 and SW 24 Street
- Upgrading M-Path crossings at SW 19 Street, SW 17 Street and SW 16 Street
- Replacing damaged drainage inlet tops
- Upgrading sidewalks, curb ramps and pavement markings
- Improving traffic and pedestrian signals and signage
