The project limits extend along SR 5/US 1/Biscayne Boulevard from NE 32 Street to NE 38 Street and along SR 25/US 27/NE 36 Street from North Miami Avenue to east of NE 5 Avenue in the City of Miami. The project started on June 19, 2017, and featured approximately \$1.8 million in roadway and safety improvements including the following work:

- Installing raised medians and widening the roadway at various locations
- Upgrading roadway signs and pedestrian ramps

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Trimming landscaping for visibility of stop signs and traffic signals

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Upgrading pedestrian ramps
- Upgrading roadway signs and pavement markings
- Installing countdown pedestrian signals at the intersection of North Miami Avenue and NE 36 Street
