## Roadway Project Begins the Week of April 23

*State Road (SR) 973/SW 87 Avenue and SR 90/US 41/SW 8 Street*

---

**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project the week of April 23, 2018. The project limits extend along SR 973/SW 87 Avenue from SW 14 Street to SW 4 Street and SR 90/US 41/SW 8 Street from SW 90 Avenue to SW 86 Court in Miami-Dade County. The project will cost an estimated \$1.4 million. This project will last approximately seven months and includes the work below.

Work to be performed along SW 87 Avenue:

- Installing island traffic separators at SW 12 Street and SW 4 Street
- Providing standard length for the left turn lane at northbound SW 14 Street, SW 12 Street and SW 9 Terrace

Work to be performed along SW 8 Street:

- Extending traffic separators at SW 90 Avenue and SW 88 Avenue
- Adding a new traffic signal at SW 89 Avenue
- Extending the left turn lane at westbound SW 89 Avenue
- Extending both eastbound and westbound dual left turn lanes at the SW 87 Avenue
- Adding an island traffic separator at Festival Plaza
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Installing signage
- Updating lighting at SW 89 Avenue and SW 87 Avenue

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to temporarily close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.**
