Lane Closures on State Road (SR) 826

Miami, FL – The following closures on SR 826 will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to remove a Dynamic Message Sign over the travel lanes.

Wednesday, May 9 - There will be two westbound travel lanes on SR 826 closed from east of NW 67 Avenue to approximately three quarters of a mile west of NW 67 Avenue between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Thursday, May 10 - There will be two westbound travel lanes on SR 826 closed from east of 17 Avenue to west of 19 Avenue between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. In addition, the entrance ramp from NW 167 Street and NW 18 Avenue to westbound SR 826 will be closed during the same time frame. Drivers can:

- Continue westbound on NW 167 Street
- Access the SR 826 entrance ramp after NW 27 Avenue

Friday, May 11 - There will be two eastbound lanes on SR 932/NW 103 Street closed from NW 11 Avenue to NW 10 Avenue between the hours of 10 p.m. and 8 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-95 Design/Build Project to replace Intelligent Transportation Systems Devices (ITS) such as Toll Amount and Lane Status Dynamic Message Signs, Incident Management Dynamic Message Signs and cameras. The project will also install a Warning Gate System at the entrances to the 95 Express Lanes the Golden Glades Park and Ride Facility as well as SR 112.
