State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway from Mile Marker (MM) 38.647 to MM 39.993

Roadway Project Begins the Week of May 28

Monroe County, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project during the week of May 28, 2018. The project limits extend along SR 5/US 1 /Overseas Highway from Ohio-Bahia Honda Channel MM 38.647 to Seven Mile Bridge MM 39.993 in Monroe County. The project will cost an estimated \$1.8 million. The work will last roughly seven months and includes the following:

- Repaving and restriping of the roadway
- Widening the roadway at various locations to provide continuous bicycle paths
- Installing new signage and pavement markings
- Upgrading guardrail to current standards
- Adding a sidewalk connection at the southbound bus stop on Ohio Key
- Installing pedestrian and bullet railings on bridges
