Roadway Safety Project Begins the Week of June 4

State Road (SR) 953/SW/NW 42 Avenue/LeJeune Road from SW 2 Street to NW 11 Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway safety improvement project the week of June 4, 2018. The project limits extend along SR 953/SW/NW 42 Avenue/LeJeune Road from SW 2 Street to NW 11 Street in the City of Miami. The project will cost an estimated \$1.5 million. This project will last approximately six months and includes the work below:

- Upgrading crosswalks
- Upgrading the pedestrian curb ramps at W Flagler Street, NW 3 Street and NW 7 Street
- Installing signage and pedestrian countdown signals
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Replacing existing traffic signals at W Flagler Street, NW 3 Street and NW 7 Street
- Reconstructing the traffic separator at SW 2 Street and NW 9 Street to adjust the left-turn lane capacity
- Removing landscaping from traffic separator just north of NW 9 Street
- Installing a concrete island traffic separator at NW 9 Street

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to temporarily close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
