Roadway Project Begins the Week of June 4

State Road (SR) 976/SW 40 Street/Bird Road

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of June 4, 2018. The project limits extend along SR 976/SW 40 Street/Bird Road from east of SW 102 Avenue to east of SR 973/SW 87 Avenue/Galloway Road in Miami-Dade County. This project will cost an estimated \$2.6 million. The work will last roughly ten months and includes the following:

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Upgrading pavement markings, pedestrian curb ramps, signs and signals

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
