Krome Avenue Closed for Railroad Crossing Repairs

Miami, FL – Beginning at 5:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 30, 2018 until midnight on Monday, July 2, 2018, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and CSX Transportation will close the railroad crossing located on State Road 997/Krome Avenue (north of SW 232 Street) for these days, weather permitting. During this time, all traffic will be detoured away from Krome Avenue and directed to follow signs to alternate local roads.

This detour is being established to allow workers to perform construction on the CSX railroad crossing. During the closure, workers will replace the existing tracks and crossing surface to improve ride quality.

Detour Intent

Krome Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic at CSX Railroad Crossing No. 631137L north of SW 232 Street.

Northbound Detour

Northbound traffic (main detour) on Krome Avenue will be directed to make a right turn at eastbound SW 232 Street, a left turn at northbound SW 167 Avenue, then traffic will make a left turn at westbound SW 216 Street and will continue to Krome Avenue.

Southbound Detour

Southbound traffic (main detour) on Krome Avenue will be directed to make a right turn at westbound SW 216 Street, a left turn at southbound SW 187 Avenue, then traffic will make a left turn at eastbound SW 232 Street and will continue to Krome Avenue.
