## **FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for a Safety Improvement Project**

*State Road (SR) 959/Red Road/SW 57 Avenue between SW 44 Street and SW 45 Street*

**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for a safety improvement project along SR 959/Red Road/SW 57 Avenue between SW 44 Street and SW 45 Street, in Miami-Dade County. The project is expected to last approximately seven months with active construction beginning in early 2019 and lasting two months. Please note that the construction duration is subject to change. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$80,000.

**The public meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at Coral Gables Congregational Church in the Havighorst Lounge, 3010 De Soto Boulevard, Coral Gables, FL 33134.** Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the projects.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Removing existing traffic signals and safety devices
- Installing a new traffic signal
- Enhancing pedestrian signals, detectors and pedestrian crossing signs as needed
