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State Road (SR) 90/SW 8 Street/Tamiami Trail

Asphalt Repair Work Begins Week of July 16

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin asphalt repair work along SR 90/SW 8 Street/Tamiami Trail from the Collier County line to west of Loop Road. The paving is scheduled to start the week of July 16 and is scheduled through August 16.

The paving and pavement marking operations are expected to start along the westbound lane and progress to the eastbound lane. Intermittent lane closures will be implemented during the work. Flaggers will be used to direct traffic and temporarily stop one direction at a time throughout the day to maintain flow. Motorists must be prepared to stop.

Work may be performed during non-peak hours:

- 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., weekdays
- 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday nights
- 11 p.m. to 7 a.m., Friday and Saturday night

Access to driveways will be maintained, but will be temporarily restricted when the contractor is working directly in front of a property.
