I-75/SR 826 Palmetto Express Lanes Project Public Meetings Scheduled

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six is preparing for the opening of the I-75/State Road (SR) 826 Palmetto Express Lanes, along SR 826/Palmetto Expressway from West Flagler Street to NW 154 Street and along I-75 from NW 154 Street to NW 170 Street in Miami-Dade County. This design-build project began on March 31, 2014 and it is anticipated to end in fall 2018. The express lanes are tentatively scheduled to open in late 2018.

As part of our commitment to keep the public informed, the department will be holding three public meetings. Each meeting will consist of a PowerPoint presentation, and other informative materials, such as, maps, brochures and graphic boards. The I-75/Palmetto Express Lanes project team will also be present to answer any questions or concerns the public may have.
