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## **FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for a Safety Project**

*State Road (SR) 93/I-75 Frontage Roads/NW 138 Street*

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**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Public Hearing for a safety project along SR 93/I-75 Frontage Roads/NW 138 Street from Hialeah Gardens Boulevard to West 23 Avenue, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in June 2020 and last about seven months. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$1.9 million.

**The Public Hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, August 21, 2018, at the Hialeah Gardens Branch Library, 11300 NW 87 Court, Hialeah Gardens, FL 33018.** The hearing and formal presentation will begin at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Restricting left-turn movement for northbound traffic coming from the driveway immediately east of West 24 Avenue
- Widening the unpaved shoulder to provide bike lanes and adding bicycle lane signage and pavement markings
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Relocating the existing guardrail
- Extending the existing sidewalk and curb and gutter
- Upgrading pedestrian ramps at West 32 Avenue and NW 87 Avenue
- Upgrading pavement markings, signage and drainage
- Relocating the light pole in conflict with the proposed guardrail
- Widening the roadway to provide an exclusive westbound left-turn lane at West 24 Avenue
- Relocating the northbound stop bar to be closer to the intersection of West 24 Avenue and NW 138 Street
- Trimming overgrown trees along NW 138 Street
