I-95 and 95 Express Lane Closures

Miami, FL – The following closures on I-95 and 95 Express will be scheduled as noted below:

SPECIAL NOTES:

- **Continuous closures are noted in red.**
- **Drivers should expect heavier than normal delays when traveling along the highlighted closure limits. Drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes during closures.**
- **There are no lane closures scheduled for the Labor Day Weekend.**

Weekend Closures

Friday, August 24 through Monday, August 27

- On Friday, August 24, there will be four lanes closed from north of SR 836 to NW 32 Street between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Two northbound general-purpose lanes from SR 836 to NW 32 Street will remain closed until 3 p.m. on Saturday, August 25 to allow the newly poured concrete pavement to cure. One lane on the eastbound SR 836 and westbound I-395 ramp lane to northbound I-95 will also be closed on Friday, August 24 between the hours of 11 p.m. to 3 p.m. The northbound I-95 ramp lane to east I-195 (Exit 4A) will also be closed during this time frame.
- All northbound 95 Express Lanes from SR 112 to the Golden Glades Interchange will be closed from 11 p.m. to 11 a.m. on Saturday, August 25, and from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. on Sunday, August 26.
- **Two northbound general-purpose lanes from SR 112 to NW 62 Street will be continuously closed starting at 8 p.m. on Saturday, until 5:30 a.m. on Monday.**
- All southbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 will be closed on Friday from 11 p.m. to 11 a.m., and on Saturday from 11:45 p.m. to 11 a.m., and again from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. One southbound, general purpose lane adjacent to the express lanes from NW 79 Street to NW 54 Street will be closed during the same time frame.
- The outside, northbound I-95 shoulder will be closed from SR 112 to NW 54 Street on Saturday, August 25 between the hours of 7 a.m. and 11 a.m.

95 Express Lanes Closures

Thursday, August 23 and Tuesday, August 28 through Thursday, August 30 - All southbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 will be closed nightly, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Tuesday, August 28 through Thursday, August 30 - All northbound 95 Express Lanes from SR 112 to the Golden Glades Interchange will be closed nightly, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

General Purpose Lanes and Ramp Closures

Thursday, August 23 - There will be two northbound lanes closed from north of SR 836 to NW 32 Street between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Additionally, two northbound lanes from north of SR 836 to NW 32 Street will be closed at 11 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. One lane on the eastbound SR 836 and westbound I-395 ramp lane to northbound I-95 will also be closed from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. The northbound I-95 ramp lane to east I-195 (Exit 4A) will also be closed during this time frame.

Thursday, August 23 and Tuesday, August 28 through Thursday, August 30 - One southbound, general purpose lane adjacent to the express lanes from NW 79 Street to NW 29 Street will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Tuesday, August 28 through Thursday, August 30 - The two northbound, general purpose lanes adjacent to the express lanes from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of I-95 Design/Build Projects to construct five emergency stopping sites on I-95 from NW 62 Street to NW 131 Street and replace the concrete pavement from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street as well as replace Intelligent Transportation System devices.
