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## **FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for a Reconstruction Project**

*State Road (SR) 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road from east of NW 107 Avenue to east of NW 116 Way*

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**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is developing the design for a reconstruction project along SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road from east of NW 107 Avenue to east of NW 116 Way, in Miami-Dade County. The scope of work for this project is listed below. Construction is expected to begin in September 2021. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$91 million.

**A public hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., on Wednesday, September 5, 2018, at the Westland Gardens Park, 13501 NW 107 Avenue, Hialeah Gardens, FL 33018.** The hearing will begin as an open house, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., with a formal presentation starting at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Okeechobee Road to cross NW 116 Way via second level overpass (access from SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road to the frontage road. Hialeah Gardens Boulevard will be maintained with ramps on the first level)
- Reconstruction of:
  - SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road with concrete pavement
  - Hialeah Gardens Boulevard from south of NW South River Drive north to the entrance of Hialeah Gardens High School
  - NW 116 Way from Hialeah Gardens High School to West 68 Street on the north
  - NW South River Drive at NW 121 Way and NW 116 Way
  - the frontage road, providing bike lanes and sidewalk continuity
- Replacing existing bridge at NW 116 Way and NW 121 Way over the Miami Canal
