Nighttime Lane Closures, Traffic Shifts on West Okeechobee Road at NW 103 Street Begin September 4

Miami, FL – Beginning **Tuesday, September 4, 2018**, there will be nighttime work for several weeks just east of the intersection of State Road (SR) 25/US 27/West Okeechobee Road and SR 932/NW 103 Street while the contractor installs a new underground watermain across the road. The work will be performed Sundays through Thursdays between 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

To perform this work, eastbound and westbound traffic along West Okeechobee Road in this area will be reduced to one lane in each direction during nighttime hours only. Traffic will also be shifted around the work zone. All travel lanes are scheduled to reopen each day. This work is anticipated to take three weeks.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
