FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for a Roadway Safety Project

State Road (SR) 973/SW 87 Avenue from SW 27 Street to SW 20 Terrace

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public hearing for a roadway safety project along SR 973/SW 87 Avenue from SW 27 Street to SW 20 Terrace, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in February 2021 and last about six months. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$1.2 million.

The public hearing will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, September 11, 2018, at the West Dade Regional Library, 9445 SW 24 Street, Miami, FL 33165. The hearing and formal presentation will begin at 6 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for this project includes: adding a raised island at SW 21 Terrace to restrict eastbound and westbound left-turn and through movements; providing a raised island at SW 20 Terrace to restrict northbound and southbound left-turn movements and through movements; installing new traffic signal structures at SW 24 Street/Coral Way; extending the southbound and eastbound left-turn lanes at SW 24 Street/Coral Way; providing high emphasis crosswalks at SW 24 Street; adding pedestrian countdowns and warning signs at SW 24 Street and enhancing traffic signage.
