FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for a Roadway Project

State Road (SR) 989/Allapattah Road at SW 211 Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for an intersection improvement project at SR 989/Allapattah Road and SW 211 Street, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in December 2022 and last about eight months. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$1.2 million.

The public meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Wednesday September 12, 2018 at South Dade Regional Library, 10750 SW 211 Street, Cutler Bay, FL 33189. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the projects.

The proposed work for this project includes: widening SR 989 to provide a northbound left turn lane and extend the northbound right turn lane; improving signalization at the intersection; widening the SW 211 Street median to extend the westbound left turn lane; installing new inlets to improve storm water drainage; repaving and restriping of the roadway; and installing new signing and pavement markings.
