State Road (SR) 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue

Roadway Project Begins the Week of September 17, 2018

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project the week of September 17, 2018. The project limits extend along SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue from north of SR 934/NW 79 Street to Little River Drive in the City of Miami. The project will cost an estimated \$1.6 million. The work will take approximately eight months to be completed.

The project includes repaving and restriping the roadway; replacing sidewalk; curb and gutter; installing new pavement markings; upgrading pedestrian signs and signals; and modifying existing medians and installing new medians.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically close lanes. Construction will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods of traffic. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
