FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for a Drainage Improvement Project

State Road (SR) 9/NW 27 Avenue from SR 934/NW 79 Street to SR 932/NW 103 Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for a drainage improvement project along SR 9/NW 27 Avenue from SR 934/NW 79 Street to SR 932/NW 103 Street, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in December 2020 and last about six months. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$1.9 million.

The public meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, October 4, 2018 at the North Central Branch Library, 9590 NW 27 Avenue, Miami, FL 33147. Graphic displays will be shown and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed work for this project includes: installing additional drainage inlets, reconstructing driveways that restrict the water flow, adding new segments of drainage pipe to connect new inlets to the existing drainage system, reconstructing new segments of the bicycle lane, repaving and restriping where drainage improvements will be installed, and reconstructing sidewalks, pedestrian ramps, curb and gutter within areas of drainage improvements.
