## **FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for Two Roadway Improvement Projects**

*State Road (SR) 817/NW 27 Avenue  
from south of NW 203 Street to south of NW 215 Street*

---

**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for two roadway improvement projects along SR 817/NW 27 Avenue from south of NW 203 Street to south of NW 215 Street, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in June 2022 and last about eight months. The estimated construction cost for these projects is about \$2 million.

**The public meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, October 11, 2018, at the Betty T. Ferguson Recreational Complex Auditorium, 3000 NW 199 Street, Miami Gardens, FL 33056.** Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for these projects includes: repaving and restriping the roadway along the project limits; upgrading signs and pavement markings; improving pedestrian signals at NW 203 Street and NW 211 Street; improving the guardrail north of the Calder Casino entrance; improving lighting at the intersections of NW 203 Street, NW 207 Street, NW 2100 Block and NW 211 Street, and enhancing traffic signals at SR 817/NW 27 Avenue and NW 207 Street.
