## I-95, 95 Express Lane, State Road (SR) 112, I-195 and Local Road Closures

---

*Miami, FL* – The following closures on I-95, 95 Express, SR 112, I-195 and local roads will be scheduled as noted below:

### **SPECIAL NOTES:**

- **Drivers should expect delays when traveling along the closure limits. Drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes during closures.**
- **Continuous closures are noted in red.**
- **Please note that there will be no construction activities while the newly poured concrete pavement cures.**
- **Ongoing closures on the I-195 ramp to southbound I-95 are noted below.**

### **Weekend Closures**

**Friday, November 2 through Monday, November 5**

*Note: Drivers should expect longer than normal delays when traveling on northbound I-95 between SR 836 and NW 62 Street over the weekend.*

- All northbound 95 Express Lanes from SR 112 to the Golden Glades Interchange will be closed from 11 p.m. to 11 a.m. on Friday, November 2, 11 p.m. to 10 a.m. on Saturday, November 3, and from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. on Sunday, November 4.
- **Two to three northbound general-purpose lanes from north of SR 836 to NW 62 Street will be closed from 11 p.m. Friday, November 2 until 2:30 p.m. on Saturday, November 3, and then again from 11 p.m. on Saturday through 10 a.m. on Sunday, November 4. The lanes will be closed again from 10:30 p.m. on Sunday until 5:30 a.m. Monday, November 5. Only two lanes will remain closed on Saturday between the hours of 11 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to allow the concrete to cure.**
- All southbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 will be closed on Friday from 11p.m. to 11a.m., Saturday from 11 p.m. to 11 a.m. and on Sunday from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Two southbound, general purpose lanes adjacent to the express lanes from NW 131 Street to NW 95 Street will be closed during the same time frame.

- Two to three southbound general-purpose lanes from NW 79 Street to NW 29 Street will be closed on Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.
- Friday, November 2 and Saturday, November 3 - The NW 62 Street ramp to southbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Go north on NW 7 Avenue
  - Turn right on NW 79 Street to access the southbound I-95 entrance ramp
- Friday, November 2 and Saturday, November 3 - The southbound I-95 exit ramp to NW 69 Street will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Exit at the NW 79 Street/NW 81 Street ramp, then turn right on NW 81 Street
  - Turn left on NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 69 Street
- Friday, November 2 and Saturday, November 3 - The southbound I-95 exit ramp to NW 62 Street will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Exit at the NW 79 Street/NW 81 Street ramp, then turn right on NW 81 Street
  - Turn left on NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 62 Street

**Friday, November 9 through Sunday, November 11**

***Note: Drivers should expect longer than normal delays when traveling on northbound I-95 between SR 836 and NW 62 Street over the weekend.***

- All northbound 95 Express Lanes from SR 112 to the Golden Glades Interchange will be closed from 11 p.m. to 11 a.m. on Friday, November 9 and 11 p.m. to 11 a.m. on Saturday, November 10.
- **Two to three northbound general-purpose lanes from north of SR 836 to NW 62 Street will be continuously closed from 11 p.m. Friday, November 9 until 11 a.m. on Sunday, November 11.**
- All southbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 will be closed on Friday from 11 p.m. to 11 a.m. and on Saturday from 11 p.m. to 11 a.m. Two southbound, general purpose lanes adjacent to the express lanes from NW 131 Street to NW 95 Street will be closed during the same time frame.
- Two to three southbound general-purpose lanes from NW 79 Street to NW 29 Street will be closed on Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.
- Friday, November 9 and Saturday, November 10 - The NW 62 Street ramp to southbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Go north on NW 7 Avenue
  - Turn right on NW 79 Street to access the southbound I-95 entrance ramp
- Friday, November 9 and Saturday, November 10 - The southbound I-95 exit ramp to NW 69 Street will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Exit at the NW 79 Street/NW 81 Street ramp, then turn right on NW 81 Street
  - Turn left on NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 69 Street
- Friday, November 9 and Saturday, November 10 - The southbound I-95 exit ramp to NW 62 Street will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Exit at the NW 79 Street/NW 81 Street ramp, then turn right on NW 81 Street
  - Turn left on NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 62 Street

### **SR 112 and I-195 Ramp Closures**

Through Friday, November 30, 2018 - The contractor will be replacing the existing barrier wall on the eastbound SR 112 and westbound I-195 ramps to southbound I-95. The following lane closures/shifts have been implemented:

- The ramp lane on the eastbound SR 112 ramp to southbound I-95 has been shifted to the right.
- One lane on the westbound I-195 ramp to southbound I-95 will be continuously closed. One lane will remain open.

Temporary concrete barrier has been installed to separate the work zone from open travel lanes. The closures/shifts are expected to be in place continuously until November 30, 2018.

### **General Purpose Lanes and Ramp Closures**

Thursday, November 1 and Monday, November 5 through Thursday, November 8 - Two to three southbound, general purpose lanes from NW 79 Street to NW 29 Street will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Thursday, November 1 and Monday, November 5 through Thursday, November 8 - Two to three northbound, general purpose lanes adjacent to the express lanes from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Thursday, November 1 and Monday, November 5 through Thursday, November 8 - The NW 62 Street ramp to southbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:

- Go north on NW 7 Avenue
- Turn right on NW 79 Street to access the southbound I-95 entrance ramp

Thursday, November 1 and Monday, November 5 through Thursday, November 8 - The southbound I-95 exit ramp to NW 69 Street will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at the NW 79 Street/NW 81 Street ramp, then turn right on NW 81 Street
- Turn left on NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 69 Street

Thursday, November 1 and Monday, November 5 through Thursday, November 8 - The southbound I-95 exit ramp to NW 62 Street will be closed on Thursday between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. and on Friday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at the NW 79 Street/NW 81 Street ramp, then turn right on NW 81 Street
- Turn left on NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 62 Street

### **Local Street Closures**

Through Friday, November 30, 2018 - There will be nightly, alternating closures on NW 36 Street and NW 35 Street between 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. to allow the project contractor to replace the traffic railing on the ramps over the roadways. The closures for phase one of the work are expected to be in place until approximately November 30, 2018.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of I-95 Design/Build Projects to construct five emergency stopping sites on I-95 from NW 62 Street to NW 131 Street and replace the concrete pavement from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street as well as replace Intelligent Transportation System devices.
