FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for a Roadway Safety Project

State Road (SR) 959/NW 57 Avenue from NW 3 Street to NW 7 Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public hearing for a roadway safety project along SR 959/NW 57 Avenue from NW 3 Street to NW 7 Street, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in September 2019 and last about three months. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$350,000.

The public hearing will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Thursday, November 29, 2018, at the Antonio Maceo Park, 5135 NW 7 Street, Miami, FL 33126. The hearing and formal presentation will begin at 5:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for this project includes: installing a southbound directional median opening to restrict the westbound left turn movements from NW 6 Street; installing a raised median with pedestrian area on NW 6 Street to restrict the westbound left turn movements; adding a “Right Turn Only” sign beneath the existing “Stop” sign on the westbound approach of NW 6 Street; reconstructing the southwest corner of the intersection of SR 959/NW 57 Avenue and NW 7 Street and providing pavement widening to accommodate the northbound to southbound U-turn movements and repaving and restriping the roadway.
