Golden Glades Multimodal Transportation Facility (GGMTF)

Construction begins the week of December 17, 2018

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) began a new design-build project the week of August 6, 2018 at the Golden Glades Park & Ride Center in Miami-Dade County. A new and modern integrated Multimodal Transportation Facility will be built to upgrade the existing Golden Glades Park & Ride Center. Construction will begin the week of December 17, 2018. This project will cost an estimated \$57 million and will take approximately three-and-a-half years to be completed.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically relocate bus stops, and establish detours at the pedestrian bridge and sidewalks within the Park & Ride. Work will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods. Ticketing machines will remain operational at all times during construction. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
