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FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for Three Roadway Improvement Projects

*State Road (SR) 994/Quail Roost Drive/SW 186 Street/SW 200 Street
from west of SW 127 Avenue to SW 113 Avenue*

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for three roadway improvement projects along SR 994/Quail Roost Drive/SW 186 Street/SW 200 Street from west of SW 127 Avenue to SW 113 Avenue, in Miami-Dade County. The estimated construction cost for these projects is about \$4.7 million.

The construction schedule for each project is listed below:

- **429341-6-52-01-SR 994/Quail Roost Drive at SW 200 Street:**
Work is expected to begin in May 2020 and last about four months.
- **429341-3/5-52-01-West of SW 127 Avenue to SW 113 Avenue:**
Work is expected to begin in August 2021 and last about one year.

The public meeting will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, December 11, 2018, at the South Dade Regional Library, 10750 SW 211 Street, Cutler Bay, FL 33189. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for these projects include: installing a new traffic signal and new lighting at SW 200 Street/Caribbean Boulevard; repaving and restriping the roadway along the project limits; upgrading signs, pavement markings and pedestrian ramps, signals and adding push buttons; adding speed feedback signs on the eastbound and westbound approaches to the SW 113 Avenue and SW 200 Street intersections; enhancing pedestrian signals to countdown type and upgrading lighting at SW 122 Avenue, SW 117 Avenue and SW 115 Avenue.
