Lane Closures for Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Replacement

Miami, FL – The following closure will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to replace CCTV cameras and support poles:

Monday, February 11 through Wednesday, February 13 - The left turn lane on Opa-locka Boulevard to NW 6 Court and the inside lane on NW 6 Court just south of Opa-locka Boulevard will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Tuesday, February 12 and Thursday, February 14 - The inside left turn lane on the northbound I-95 exit ramp to westbound Ives Dairy Road will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Thursday, February 14 - The shoulder on northbound I-95 near the SW 8 Street exit ramp will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Friday, February 15 - One outside lane on southbound I-95 will be closed from NW 171 Street to NW 167 Street, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the Districtwide Design/Build Project to replace Intelligent Transportation Systems Devices (ITS).
