### **Lane Closures for Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Replacement**

**Miami, Fla.** – The following closure will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to replace CCTV cameras and support poles:

- Monday, March 11 - One outside lane on northbound I-95 will be closed from SW 18 Road to SW 11 Street between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Monday, March 11 and Tuesday, March 12 - One inside lane on the Ives Dairy Road entrance ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Tuesday, March 12 through Thursday, March 14 - Drivers on the inside lane on northbound NW 2 Avenue at approximately NW 169 Street will be shifted to the right lane between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. The ramp to northbound I-95 will remain open.
- Wednesday, March 13 - One outside lane on southbound I-95 will be closed from approximately NE 210 Street to Ives Dairy Road between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Wednesday, March 13 and Friday, March 15- The NW 125 Street entrance ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Go north on NW 6 Avenue to NW 131 Street.
  - Turn west on NW 131 Street and turn north on NW 7 Avenue.
  - Turn east on NW 135 Street to access the northbound I-95 entrance ramp.

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.** The closures are part of the Districtwide Design/Build Project to replace Intelligent Transportation Systems Devices (ITS).
