Lane Closures for Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Replacement

Miami, Fla. – The following closure will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to replace CCTV cameras and support poles:

- Monday, March 18 – One outside lane on northbound I-95 will be closed north of Miami Gardens Drive between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Tuesday, March 19 – One outside lane on southbound I-95 will be closed from approximately NW 106 Street to NW 102 Street between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Thursday, March 21 and Friday, March 22- The ramp from NW 151 Street to southbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Driver can:
 - Turn south at NW 7 Avenue
 - Turn east at NW 135 Street to access the southbound I-95 entrance ramp

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the Districtwide Design/Build Project to replace Intelligent Transportation Systems Devices (ITS).
