I-95, 95 Express, State Road (SR) 112 and I-195 Lane Closures

Miami, Fla. – The following closures on I-95, 95 Express, SR 112 and I-195 will be scheduled as noted below:

SPECIAL NOTES:

- Drivers should expect delays when traveling along the closure limits. Drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes during closures.
- Please note that there will be no construction activities while the newly poured concrete pavement cures.
- One lane on the westbound I-195 ramp to southbound I-95 will remain continuously closed as noted below.
- Weekend closures have been suspended due to special events.

Weeknight Closures

- One lane on the westbound I-195 ramp to southbound I-95 will remain continuously closed to allow the contractor to replace the traffic railing. The ramp lane is scheduled to remain closed until July 2019.
- Thursday, March 28 - All northbound 95 Express Lanes from SR 112 to the Golden Glades Interchange will be closed nightly, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
- Thursday, March 28 and Monday, April 1 through Thursday, April 4 - Three northbound, general-purpose lanes from NW 46 Street to NW 56 Street will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Two lanes will be closed at 9 p.m. and the third lane will be closed at 11 p.m.
- Thursday, March 28, Monday, April 1 and Tuesday, April 2 - One southbound 95 Express Lane from NW 46 Street to SR 112 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. All southbound 95 Express Lanes for the Golden Glades interchange to SR 112 will be closed between the hours 12:30 a.m. and 5:30 a.m.
- Thursday, March 28, Monday, April 1 and Tuesday, April 2 - Two southbound, general-purpose lanes from NW 54 Street to NW 32 Street will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. One lane will be closed at 9 p.m. and the second lane will be closed at 11 p.m. **ONLY ONE LANE WILL REMAIN OPEN BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 12:30 A.M. AND 5:30 A.M.**

- Wednesday, April 3 and Thursday, April 4 - Three southbound general-purpose lanes will be closed from NW 62 Street to NW 45 Street between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Two lanes will be closed at 9 p.m. and the third lane will be closed at 11 p.m.
- Thursday, March 28 and Monday, April 1 through Thursday, April 4 - There will be a full closure of NW 36 Street from NW 7 Avenue to NW 5 Avenue between 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. to allow the project contractor to replace the traffic railing on the ramps over the roadways. Drivers should follow the posted detour signs.
- Monday, April 1 - The eastbound SR 112 ramp to southbound I-95 will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Go north on I-95 and exit at NW 62 Street.
 - Turn left at NW 62 Street to access southbound I-95.
- Tuesday, April 2 - The eastbound SR 112 ramps to southbound and northbound I-95 will be closed from 11 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Continue east on SR 112/I-195, exit at North Miami Avenue.
 - Turn left at North Miami Avenue to access the westbound I-195 ramp.
 - Access the northbound or southbound I-95 ramp.
- Wednesday, April 3 and Thursday, April 4 - The eastbound SR 112 and the westbound I-195 ramps to southbound I-95 will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Go north on I-95 and exit at NW 62 Street.
 - Turn left at NW 62 Street to access southbound I-95.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of I-95 Design/Build Projects to construct five emergency stopping sites on I-95 from NW 62 Street to NW 131 Street and replace the concrete pavement from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street as well as replace Intelligent Transportation System devices.
