Roadway Project Begins the Week of May 13

State Road (SR) 9/NW 27 Avenue

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway safety improvement project the week of May 13, 2019. The project limits extend along SR 9/NW 27 Avenue from NW 23 Street to NW 26 Street in Miami-Dade County. This project will last approximately five months. The project will cost an estimated \$672,521.

The project includes installing a traffic signal and street lighting at the intersection of NW 27 Avenue and NW 24 Street, adding pedestrian and bicyclist warning signs, adding high-emphasis pedestrian crosswalks, relocating an existing bus stop closer to the signalized intersection, eliminating the left turn movement from westbound NW 23 Street onto southbound NW 27 Avenue and modifying the traffic separator along NW 27 Avenue.

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to temporarily close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
