State Road (SR) 997/Krome Avenue
Weekend Closure Between SW 168 Street and SW 192 Street
Detour Will Guide Drivers Around the Work Beginning Friday Night, June 7

Miami, Fla. – Beginning at 11 p.m. on Friday, June 7, Krome Avenue will be continuously closed to through traffic between SW 168 Street and SW 192 Street through 5:30 a.m. on Monday, June 10 while the contractor prepares for a traffic shift. A detour will be established to guide drivers around the work. Local access to the properties in this area will be maintained at all times during the weekend closure, but motorists may need to use the detour to arrive to their destination.

Drivers traveling south on Krome Avenue wishing to continue south will have to:

- Turn west on SW 168 Street/Richmond Drive
- Turn south on SW 197 Avenue/Grossman Drive
- Turn east on SW 192 Street
- Turn south on Krome Avenue

Drivers traveling north on Krome Avenue wishing to continue north will have to:

- Turn west on SW 192 Street
- Turn north on SW 197 Avenue/Grossman Drive
- Turn east on SW 168 Street/Richmond Drive
- Turn north on Krome Avenue

Eastbound and westbound traffic on SW 184 Street/Eureka Drive at Krome Avenue will remain open during this work.

Once the traffic shift is in place, one northbound and one southbound lane will be open on the east side of Krome Avenue between SW 232 Street and SW 171 Street and on the west side of Krome Avenue between SW 171 Street and SW 136 Street.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
