Roadway Project Begins the Week of June 17

NW 34 Avenue Bridge over the Comfort Canal

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a bridge replacement project the week of June 17, 2019. The project limits extend along the NW 34 Avenue bridge located over the Comfort Canal between NW 14 Street and NW 13 Street in the City of Miami. This project will last approximately ten months. The project will cost an estimated \$1.3 million.

The project includes replacing the bridge along NW 34 Avenue over the Comfort Canal between NW 14 Street and NW 13 Street, repaving and restriping the roadway within the project limits and upgrading pedestrian curb ramps.

To complete this work safely, the NW 34 Avenue bridge over the Comfort Canal between NW 14 Street and NW 13 Street will be closed to vehicular access throughout the life of the project. Northbound and southbound motorists along NW 34 Avenue will be detoured to NW 37 Avenue. Pedestrians will be able to cross the Comfort Canal using a temporary pedestrian bridge.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
