Weekend Closures on I-95 and Adjacent Ramps

SPECIAL NOTES:

- **Drivers should expect delays when traveling along the closure limits. Drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes during closures.**
- Please note that there will be no construction activities while the newly poured concrete pavement cures.
- **Continuous closures are noted in red.**

Northbound I-95 Closures

- Friday, June 21 and Saturday, June 22 - Three lanes on northbound I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 24 Street will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. **Only one lane will remain open on northbound mainline I-95 from the Exit 4A entrance ramp to NW 24 Street.**
- Saturday, June 22 and Sunday, June 23 - Two lanes on northbound I-95 will be closed from NW 8 Street to NW 24 Street, between the hours of 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- **Friday, June 21 through Monday, June 24 - Two northbound, I-95 lanes will be continuously closed from NW 24 Street to NW 46 Street starting at 11 p.m. on Friday, June 21, until 5:30 a.m. on Monday, June 24.** Two additional northbound, general-purpose lanes from NW 24 Street to NW 46 Street will be closed on Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m., and on Sunday between the hours of 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. **Only one northbound, general-purpose lane will be open between 11 p.m. and 9 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.**

Southbound I-95 Closures

- Friday, June 21 and Saturday, June 22 - All southbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 will be closed on Friday and Saturday, between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.

- Friday, June 21 and Saturday, June 22 - Two to three southbound, general-purpose lanes will be closed from NW 81 Street to NW 46 Street on Friday and Saturday, between the hours 11 p.m. to 11 a.m.
- Friday, June 21 and Saturday, June 22 - Three lanes on southbound I-95 from NW 29 Street to NW 17 Street will be closed from 11 p.m. to 11 a.m.
- Saturday, June 22 and Sunday, June 23 - Two lanes on southbound I-95 will be closed from NW 29 Street to NW 17 Street, between the hours of 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Ramp Closures

- Friday, June 21 and Saturday, June 22 - One lane on the westbound I-395 and eastbound SR 836 ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. on Friday, June 21 and 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Saturday, June 22.
- Saturday, June 22 - The westbound I-195 and eastbound SR 112 ramps to southbound I-95 will be closed on Saturday, between the hours of 11:45 p.m. and 9 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Go north on I-95, exit at NW 62 Street, then turn left on NW 62 Street.
 - Go south on I-95 to access the SR 112 and I-195 ramps.

Local Road Closure

- Friday, June 21 - NW 7 Avenue will be closed from NW 46 Street to NW 36 Street on Friday, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
 - Drivers on northbound NW 7 Avenue can:
 - Turn right on NW 36 Street, then turn left on NW 3 Avenue.
 - Turn left on NW 46 Street to access NW 7 Avenue.
 - Drivers on southbound NW 7 Avenue can:
 - Turn right on NW 46 Street, then turn left on NW 10 Avenue.
 - Turn left on NW 36 Street to access NW 7 Avenue.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of I-95 Design/Build Projects to construct five emergency stopping sites on I-95 from NW 62 Street to NW 131 Street and replace the concrete pavement from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street as well as replace Intelligent Transportation System devices.
