### **FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for Roadway and Safety Improvement Projects**

*SR 860/NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive from west of NW 57 Avenue to west of NW 27 Avenue*

**Miami, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Public Hearing for roadway and safety improvement projects along SR 860/NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive from west of NW 57 Avenue to west of NW 27 Avenue, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in January 2021 and last about 13 months. The estimated construction cost for these projects is about \$6 million.

**A Public Hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, July 16, 2019 at the City of Miami Gardens Council Chambers, 18605 NW 27 Avenue, Miami Gardens, FL 33056.** A formal presentation will start at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed improvements include: repaving and restriping within the project limits, constructing and reconstructing sidewalks, reconstructing pedestrian curb ramps and relocating pedestrian crosswalk push-button signal detectors and signs, upgrading transit bus stop locations to current standards, enhancing pedestrian street lighting and adding video detection at signalized intersections, upgrading pavement markings and signage, modifying the median opening directly west of NW 57 Avenue to restrict the northbound left-turn movement from the driveway onto westbound SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive, installing a “Right-Turn Only” sign and “Stop” sign on the northbound right-turn lane west of NW 57 Avenue and converting the existing northbound left-turn lane into a painted median, and installing a “No U-turn” sign on the westbound and eastbound approaches of the directional median opening west of NW 57 Avenue.
