**NW 87 Avenue Road Continuously Opens Between NW 103 Street, NW 74 Street**  
*Includes new bridge, section of road*

**Miami, Fla.** – On Saturday, July 13, NW 87 Avenue is expected to be fully open between NW 103 Street and NW 74 Street in the City of Hialeah Gardens and Town of Medley. Motorists can now continuously travel along NW 87 Avenue over the Miami River Canal as well as a new section of roadway between NW 96 Street and NW 93 Street. This connectivity provides drivers an alternate route in this area.

“This project is providing the long-awaited missing link along NW 87 Avenue that will help alleviate traffic congestion in the area,” said District Six Secretary Jim Wolfe. “The new bridge and wider roadway will not only improve traffic flow but will make the corridor more welcoming for the businesses in this community.”

The project is scheduled to be completed by the end of July. Miami-Dade County will maintain this section of NW 87 Avenue.
