Landscape Project Begins the Week of July 15

*Miami Gardens Drive Park & Ride Lot along State Road (SR) 860/NW 183 Street/Miami
Gardens Drive*

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a landscaping project the week of July 15, 2019. The project limits are within the Miami Gardens Drive Park and Ride Lot located west of I-75 along SR 860/NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive in Miami-Dade County. This project will last approximately three months for installation of landscaping and two years for maintenance of work. The project will cost an estimated \$220,000.

The project includes installing trees and palms within the Miami Gardens Drive Park and Ride Lot.

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to temporarily close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
