Roadway Construction Project Begins the Week of September 23

State Road (SR) 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of September 23, 2019. The project limits extend along the intersection of SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway and SW 127 Avenue/SW 232 Street. This project will cost an estimated \$457,000.

The work will last roughly five months and includes the following: enhancing traffic signals; improving signage at the intersection; repaving and restriping the intersection; reconstructing pedestrian ramps.

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
