### **Lane Closures for State Road (SR) 112/I-195 Roadway and Signage Improvement Project**

**Miami, Fla.** – The following closure will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to install barrier wall adjacent to the roadway:

- Tuesday, October 8 (Wednesday, October 9 is an alternate date) - The exit ramp from eastbound I-195 to northbound Alton Road will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Motorists will still be able access the left eastbound I-195 lane to exit onto SR 112/Arthur Godfrey Road/41 Street. Motorists wishing to continue northbound on the Alton Road Ramp will be directed to:
  - Exit on the southbound Alton Road Ramp and continue south
  - Turn west on 29 street
  - Turn north on North Bay Road
  - Continue north on Alton Road

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.** The closures are part of the SR 9A/I-95 and SR 112/I-195 Roadway and Signage Improvement Project.
