**State Road (SR) 5/North Roosevelt Boulevard Pedestrian High-intensity Activated Crosswalks (HAWKs) and Street Lighting Project is Officially Complete**

*Project Final Accepted on September 27, 2019*

**Monroe County, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) officially completed the SR 5/North Roosevelt Boulevard Pedestrian HAWK and Street Lighting Project on September 27, 2019.

The project extended along SR 5/North Roosevelt Boulevard in Key West. It started on February 4, 2019, and included approximately \$1.6 million in roadway, pedestrian and signalization enhancements. Scope of work included the installation of pedestrian HAWKs at five mid-block crossings, upgrading pedestrian signing and pavement markings, upgrading street lighting and repaving and restriping isolated sections of the roadway.

This roadway project is one of many FDOT projects that have been put in place to enhance safety and pedestrian mobility along state roads.
