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Bridge Rehabilitation Project Begins Week of November 11 *State Road (SR) 93/I-75 northbound exit ramp at NW 138 Street*

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a bridge rehabilitation project the week of November 11, 2019. The project limits extend along SR 93/I-75 northbound exit ramp at NW 138 Street (bridge number 870604) in the City of Hialeah. The project will cost an estimated \$1.1 million.

The work will take roughly 10 months to be completed. The project includes cleaning and painting bridge steel structures; upgrading and replacing bridge joints; and repairing concrete bridge railing.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically close lanes. Construction will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods of traffic. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zone.
