### **NW 12 Avenue Closed for Railroad Crossing Work**

**Miami, Fla.** – Beginning at 10:00 p.m. on Friday, November 15, 2019, until Wednesday November 20, 2019 at 4:00 a.m., the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will close State Road 933/NW 12 Avenue at the railroad crossing located between NW 21 Street. and NW 21 Terrace in the City of Miami, Miami-Dade County for these days, weather permitting. During this time, all northbound and southbound traffic will be detoured away from this crossing and directed to follow signs to alternate local streets.

This detour is being established to allow workers to perform necessary roadway work to the South Florida Rail Corridor (SFRC Downtown Lead) During the closure, workers will remove the existing railroad tracks to improve ride quality.

Traffic traveling northbound on NW 12 Avenue will be directed to make a right at NW 20 Street, a left at NW 10th Avenue, another left at NW 28 Street and will continue until NW 12 Avenue.

Traffic traveling southbound on NW 12 Avenue will be directed to make a right at NW 28 Street, a left at NW 14 Avenue, another left at NW 20 Street and will continue until NW 12 Avenue.
