Full Closure of Westbound I-395

Miami, Fla. – On Wednesday, December 18, all westbound I-395 lanes will be closed at Biscayne Boulevard between the hours of 11:59 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

- Westbound drivers on the MacArthur Causeway can:
 - Exit at Biscayne Boulevard (Exit 2)
 - Turn left at Biscayne Boulevard and continue right at SE 2 Street
 - Turn left at SE 2 Avenue to access the I-95 ramps
 - Drivers heading to SR 836 can go north on I-95 to access the westbound SR 836 Ramp
- Westbound drivers on NE 13 Street accessing the I-395 ramp at NE 1 Avenue can:
 - Continue west on NE 13 Street
 - Turn left on North Miami Avenue, then turn left on NE 10 Street
 - Turn right on Biscayne Boulevard and continue right at SE 2 Street
 - Turn left at SE 2 Avenue to access the I-95 ramps
 - Drivers heading to SR 836 can go north on I-95 to access the westbound SR 836 Ramp
- Drivers on northbound NE 1 Avenue can:
 - Turn right on NE 10 Street
 - Turn right on Biscayne Boulevard and continue right at SE 2 Street
 - Turn left at SE 2 Avenue to access the I-95 ramps
 - Drivers heading to SR 836 can go north on I-95 to access the westbound SR 836 Ramp

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
