FDOT to Host Public Meeting for State Road (SR) 934/Normandy Drive Roadway Projects *Construction Begins the Week of January 6*

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a public information meeting for an upcoming roadway project along SR 934/Normandy Drive at the intersection of Rue Granville and from Rue Versailles to Bay Drive. **The meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., Tuesday, January 7, 2020 at the North Shore Park and Youth Center, 501 72 Street, Miami Beach, FL 33141.** Graphic displays and project plans will be shown during the meeting and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions from the public.

The project will begin the week of January 6, last about six months and cost an estimated \$900,000. Work includes:

- *SR 934/Normandy Drive at Rue Granville*: repaving and restriping the road; removing on-street parking to install a new pedestrian crossing and overhead signs; upgrading sidewalks, curb ramps, signs and pavement markings; and relocating an existing bus stop from the west side of the intersection to the east sides
- *SR 934/Normandy Drive from Rue Versailles to Bay Drive*: widening, repaving and restriping the road; installing a raised median; removing on-street parking to install a new crosswalk at the intersection of Rue Versailles; upgrading sidewalks, pedestrian curb ramps, signs and pavement markings; and improving traffic signals and street lights.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
