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FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for one Bridge Project and a Public Hearing for a Roadway Safety Improvement Project *March 10, 2020*

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Public Meeting for one bridge project from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. and a Public Hearing for a roadway safety improvement project from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, March 10, 2020 at the Miami Beach Golf Club located at 2301 Alton Road, Miami Beach, FL 33140.

These projects limits extend along State Road (112)/I-195 over the Westshore Waterway Bridge (next to Martell Park) and at the intersection of SR 112/West 41 Street/Arthur Godfrey Road and Jefferson Avenue.

The proposed improvements, construction start date, duration and the estimated cost for both projects are below:

State Road (SR) 112/I-195 over the Westshore Waterway Bridge (next to Martell Park): The proposed work for this project includes: repairing the deck on both bridges; replacing the expansion joints and repairing the seawall and columns underneath the bridges. Construction is expected to begin in April 2021 and last about nine months. The estimated construction cost for this project is \$1 million.

The Public Meeting will follow an informal format allowing the public to arrive at any time from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss this project and answer questions.

SR 112/West 41 Street/Arthur Godfrey Road and Jefferson Avenue: The proposed work for this project includes: eliminating the left turn from eastbound SR 112/W 41 Street/Arthur Godfrey Road to northbound Jefferson Avenue; installing a new traffic signal and pedestrian crosswalk at the intersection; removing some landscape to install the new signal and moving the existing traffic school signal at Meridian Avenue to just east of Alton Road to extend the school zone. Construction start date is to be determined, but will last about four months. The estimated construction cost for this project is \$200,000.

The Public Hearing will follow an informal format allowing the public to arrive at any time from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m., with a formal presentation starting at 5:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the hearing, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss these projects and answer questions.
