FDOT to Host Public Meeting for Upcoming Roadway Construction Project

State Road (SR) 925/NW 3 Court/NW 3 Avenue from NW 1 Street to NW 8 Street

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a public meeting for an upcoming roadway construction project along SR 925/NW 3 Court/NW 3 Avenue from NW 1 Street to NW 8 Street, in Miami-Dade County. **The meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on, Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at Lummus Park, 404 NW 3 Street, Miami, Florida, 33128.** Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

Construction is scheduled to begin the week of April 13, 2020 and will last roughly eleven months. The estimated construction cost for this project is \$5.1 million and includes the following: reconstructing pedestrian curb ramps; enhancing sidewalks, guardrails and installing new drainage structures; improving vehicular traffic and pedestrian signals and signage; installing bicycle lane signage and pavement markings; repaving and restriping the roadway.
