**FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for a Roadway Improvement Project on  
State Road (SR) 826/Palmetto Expressway Frontage Road**

*March 11, 2020*

**Miami, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Public Meeting for a roadway project on SR 826/Palmetto Expressway Frontage Road from NW 122 Street to NW 138 Street from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 11, 2020 at Tony’s Reception Banquet Hall located at 1800 West 68 Street, Hialeah, FL 33014.

The proposed improvements include: installing a new stormwater drainage system; repaving and restriping the roadway and upgrading pedestrian curb ramps, signage and pavement markings. Construction is expected to begin in October 2021 and last about seven months. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$2 million.

The Public Meeting will follow an informal format allowing the public to arrive at any time from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss this project.
