Full Closure of Aviation Boulevard at SR 5/Overseas Highway Begins March 30

Miami, Fla. – Beginning Monday, March 30, 2020, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will continuously close Aviation Boulevard at SR 5/Overseas Highway for approximately two weeks in order to complete drainage work and begin the widening of Aviation Boulevard.

During this closure, Aviation Boulevard will remain accessible from 107 Street, on the east side of Florida Keys/Marathon International Airport, to local residents only. Electronic message boards will be installed to direct traffic through the area.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
