State Road (SR) A1A/Collins Avenue at 13 Street

Intersection Enhancement Project Begins January 23

Miami – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin an intersection enhancement construction project on Monday January 23. The project limits extend along SR A1A/Collins Avenue at 13 Street in the City of Miami Beach. The project will cost an estimated \$230,761. The work will last about four months and includes the following:

- Installing new traffic signals at the intersection of Collins Avenue and 13 Street. There are currently no signals at this intersection.
- Installing new pedestrian signals at the four corners of the intersection, including audible pedestrian signals to cross Collins Avenue
- Repaving and restriping the intersection
- Updating the signage and pavement markings

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and flagmen will be used as needed to help direct traffic.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
