Campbell Drive Traffic Shift Scheduled for Tuesday, June 23

New work zone from west of State Road (SR) 997/Krome Avenue to Flagler Avenue

Miami, Fla. – Beginning Tuesday, June 23, the contractor for the Florida Department of Transportation’s Truck Bypass Project will be implementing a traffic shift on Campbell Drive from just west of SR 997/ Krome Avenue to Flagler Avenue. Travel lanes will be shifted to the south side of the road so the contractor may continue roadway widening and drainage work.

One eastbound and one westbound lane will remain open. Left turn lanes will be provided at signalized intersections. Driveways and side streets along the north side of the road will remain open. This work is expected to last several months.
